

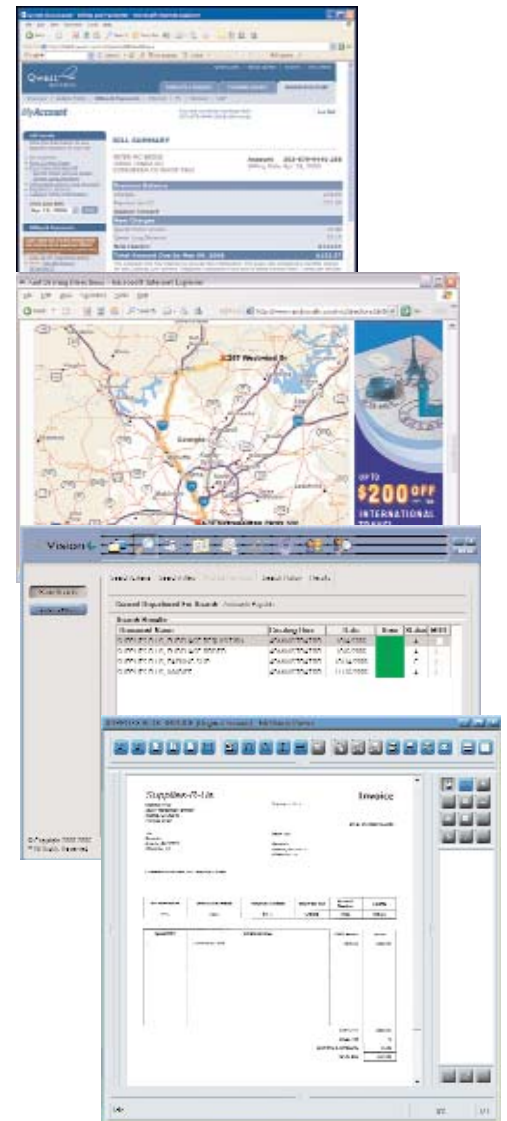
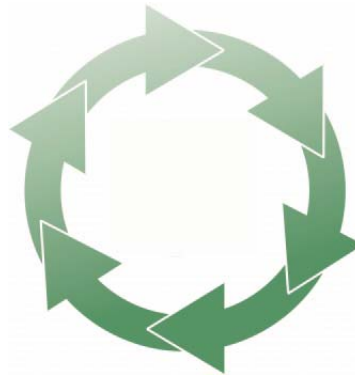
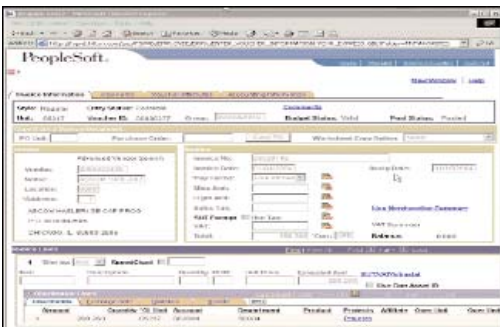
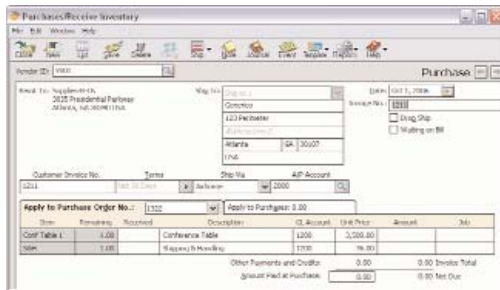


FileVision Application Integrator

Overview

FileVision recognizes the challenges businesses face with attempting to tie together disparate technology solutions that manage related data. FileVision offers end-to-end information management by linking data from electronic files with paper documents, processing action items using a workflow manager and enabling secure and easy search access to the information. To extend these capabilities to existing line of business applications FileVision has created the Application Integrator (FAI). The FAI is a simple yet cost effective solution that integrates seamlessly with other applications, leveraging current technology investments. Integration is easy using the point and click configuration of the FileVision Application Integrator. Data from other applications can be used to search for a document, index a document or populate and search the relationship management module, eliminating the time consuming task of data entry.

FileVision Application Integrator can automate the processing of new documents. Again with a simple mouse click or keystroke, Application Integrator can display a new scanned image or electronic document, fill in indexing data from any line of business application, prompt the user to add or confirm the data and then store the document appropriately. Combine this function with entering an invoice or adding a new employee and you get single step data entry. In one step, enter the data into the line of business application and file the document into FileVision without keying data twice and eliminate the possibility of introducing erroneous information.
